AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ADOPTION OF AN ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF GLENVIEW FOR THE FISCAL JULY 1, 1999 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2000, ESTIMATING REVENUES AND RESOURCES AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE CITY GOVERNMENT.




